**DESIGN AND INSTALLATION OF
FIRE ALARM AND SPRINKLER SYSTEM

CITY HALL AND THE MUNICIPAL PUBLIC WORKS FACILITY**

Four (4) sealed written proposals shall be submitted to the Office of the City Manager, City Hall, Room 102, 145 Taunton Avenue, East Providence, RI 02914 by 2:00 P.M., on Wednesday, June 6, 2007 for the design and installation of fully functional and code compliant fire alarm and sprinkler systems for the 16,614 square foot East Providence City Hall at 145 Taunton Avenue and the 44,354 square foot Municipal Public Works Facility located at 60 Commercial Way.

The systems must be installed in accordance with current codes; NFPA 1, NFPA 101, NFPA 72, and all State and local codes as amended.

A mandatory pre-proposal conference will be held at the City Hall in Room 306 on Tuesday, May 22, 2007 at 9am. Following the conference, visits to each project location shall be made.

Bid security in the amount of 5% of the total amount bid must accompany all bids.

Performance, Labor & Material Payment Bonds, in the amount of 100% of the contract price will be required of the successful bidder.

Attention of bidders is called to the provisions of Title 37, Chapter 13, General Laws of Rhode Island, as amended - 1984 Reenactment. Particular attention is called to the requirements as to conditions of employment to be observed and prevailing wage rates to be paid under the contract.

The City reserves the right to reject any and all bids, or parts thereof, to waive any informality in the bids received and to accept the bid, or parts thereof deemed to be most favorable to the best interests of the City.
